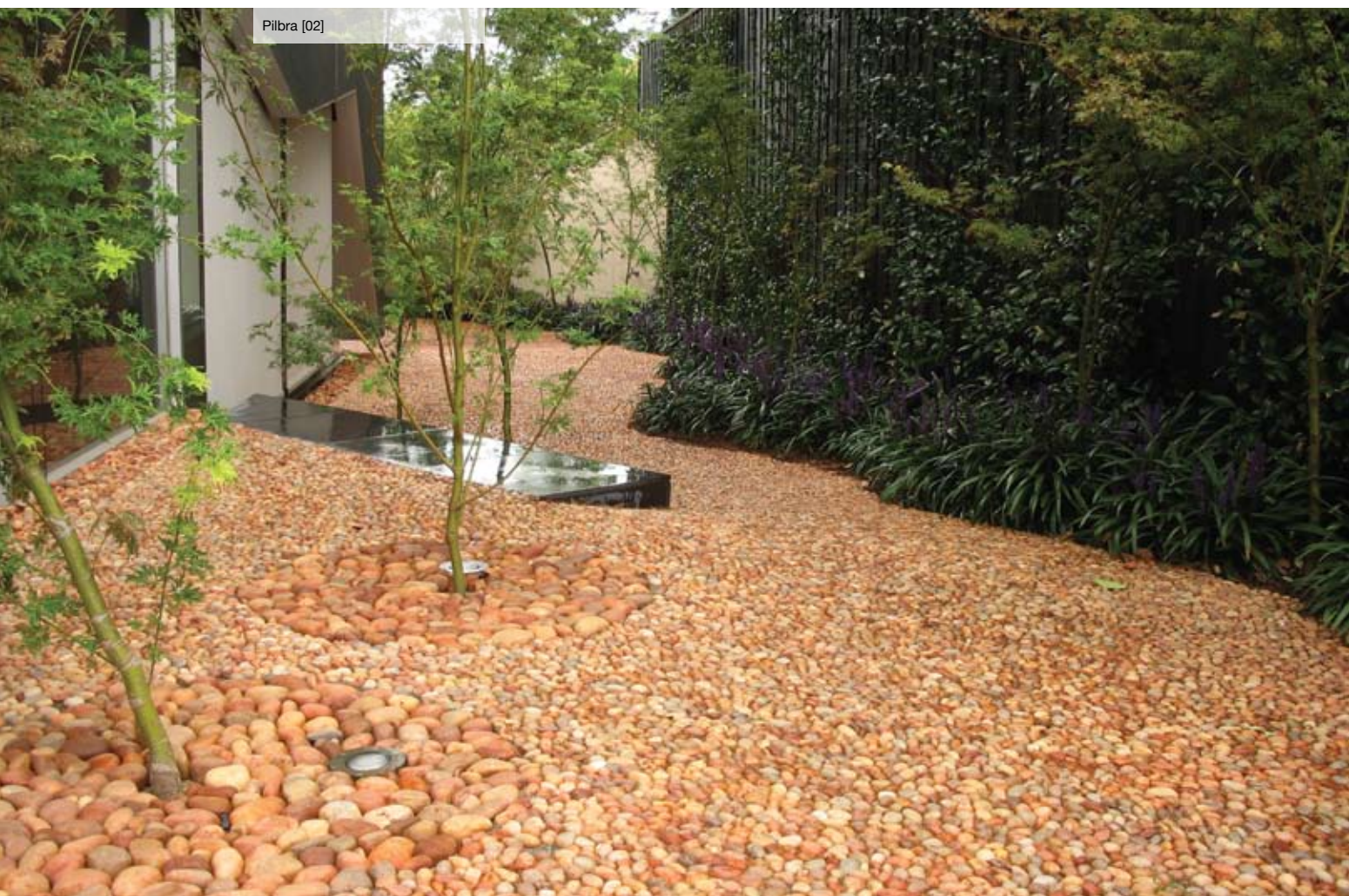

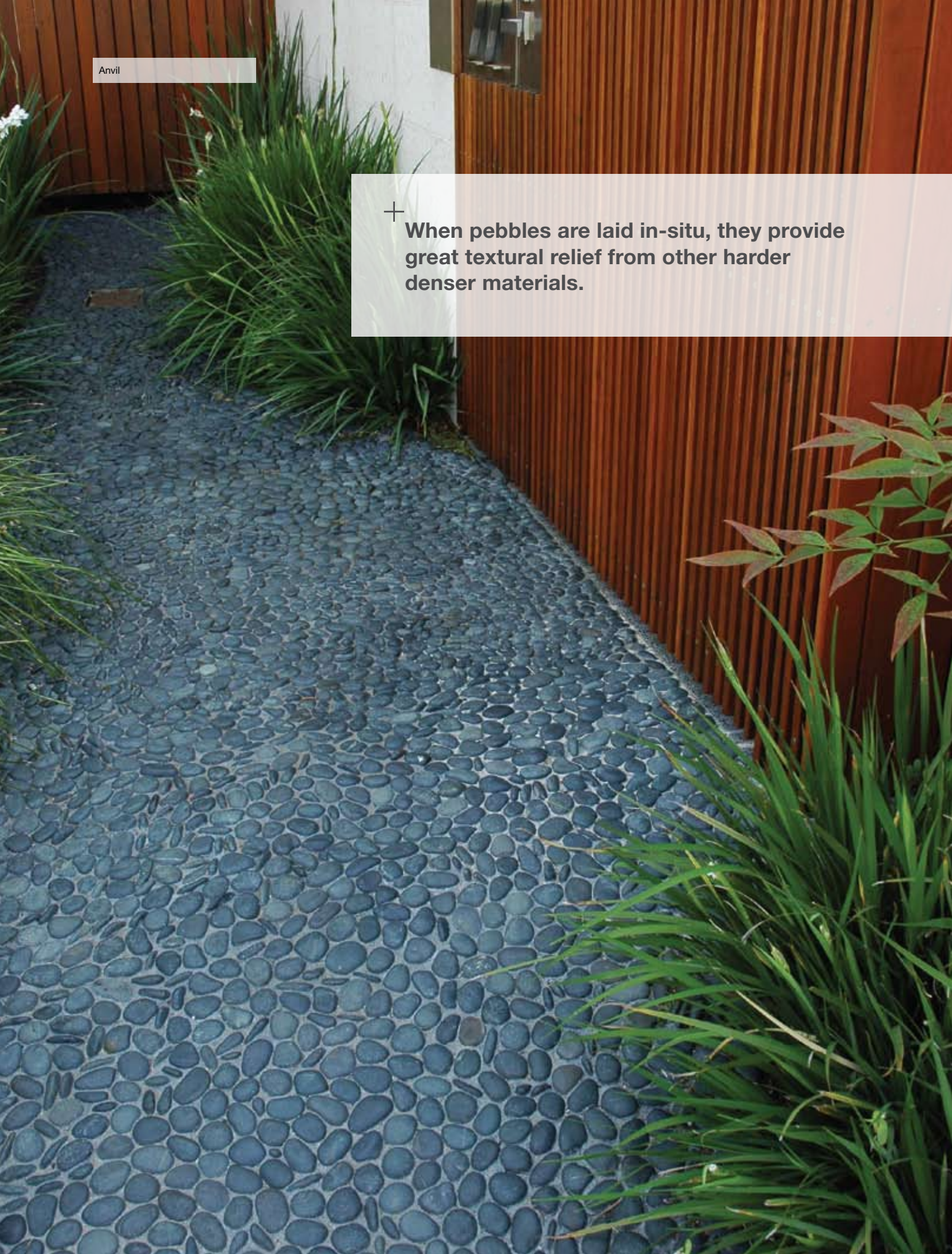

When laying pebbles on a wet mortar for a hard flooring surface, work with the natural shape of the pebble to achieve the best result. Flatter pebbles such as Bracken are best laid on edge.

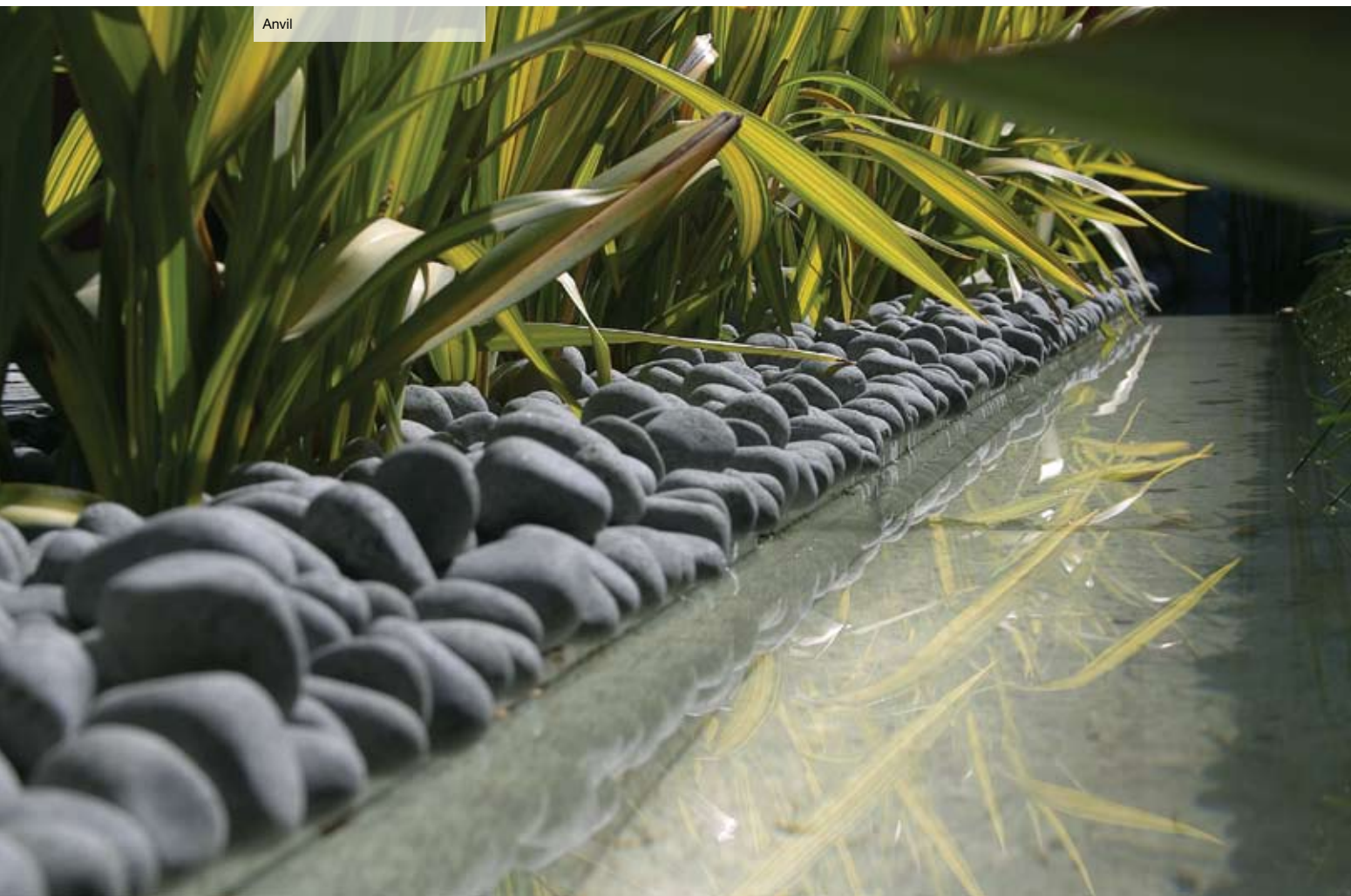

Anvil



Pebbles are an extremely versatile landscape and building material. With a huge diversity in colours, textures and sizes, pebbles can be utilized as an accent or as a key surface alternative in almost all styles of landscape architecture.

The majority of our range are manufactured from quarried stone waste such as granite, marble and quartz. Pebbles are created through a process of tumbling and are then washed, graded and packaged in user friendly 20kg bags.
