**When we select free form we look for pieces which reflect the skin of the stone and pieces which reflect the natural internal tonal variations of the stone once split. This ensures that the end result is a stunning spectrum of true to life colour.**



+ Intersperse Howqua free from pieces with Alpine dry stone to create a rugged irregular look.

+ Consider recessing the grout for a bolder design statement emphasising the structure and form of the stone.

Washing the grout over the stone mutes the colour creating a hand worked effect and a more aged appearance.

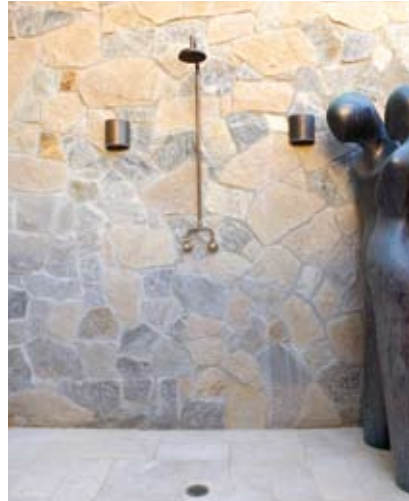

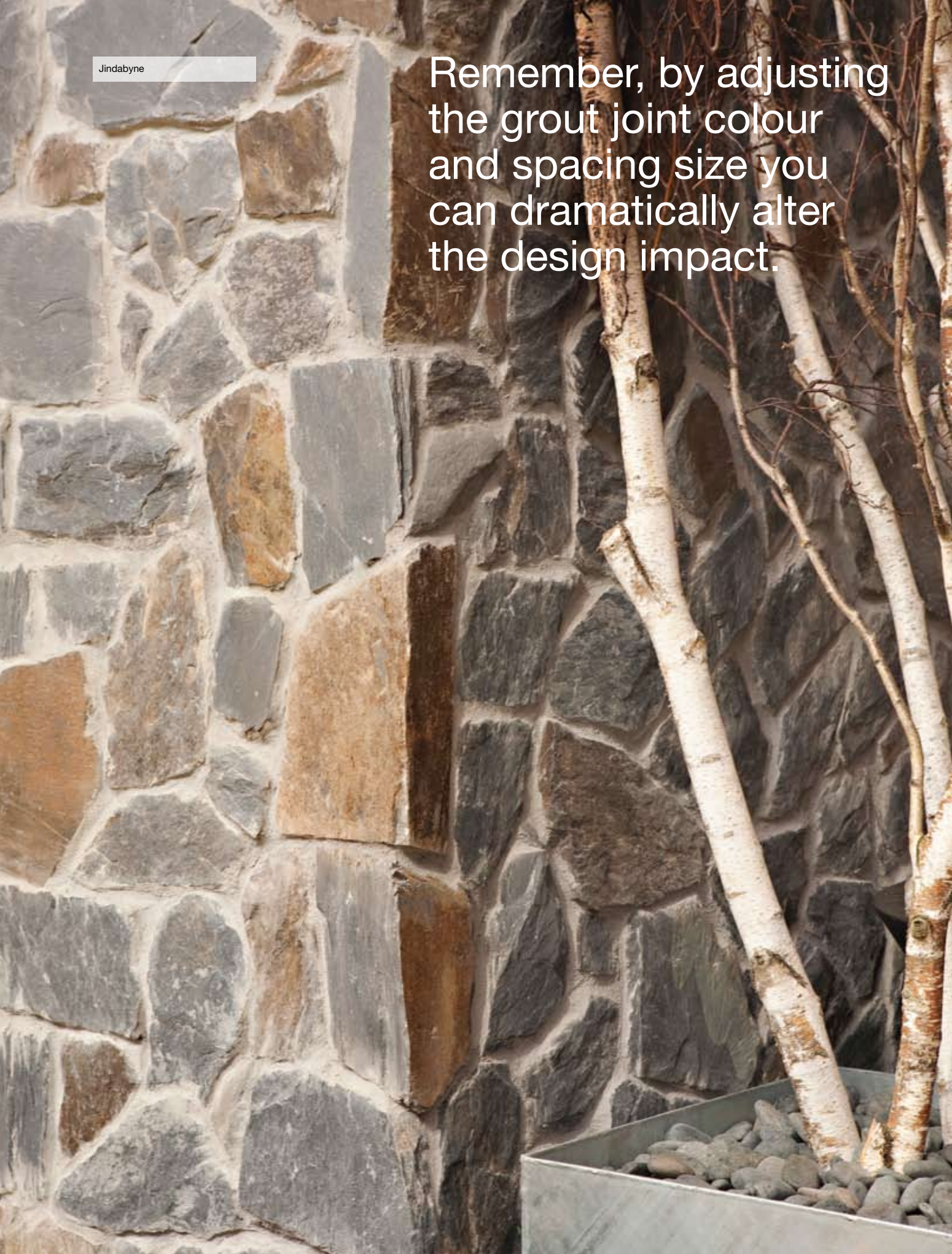

## Sizes

### Walling

#### Corners



### Walling

Split face veneer split on 5 sides and sawn on the back  
Random sizes up to 400mm  
Thickness 20-40mm

### Corners

L shaped corner pieces  
Random sizes up to 400mm  
Thickness up to 20-40mm

Typically these products are adhered to a concrete or block wall with a suitable tile adhesive. Corner details are slightly different for each stone type.

Typically Free Form walling is supplied in small easy to manage 7m<sup>2</sup> crates, while corners come in small 3 lineal meter crate lots.

When working out quantities required for a wall, you need to know the face in m<sup>2</sup> to be covered and the number of lineal meters of corners required.
