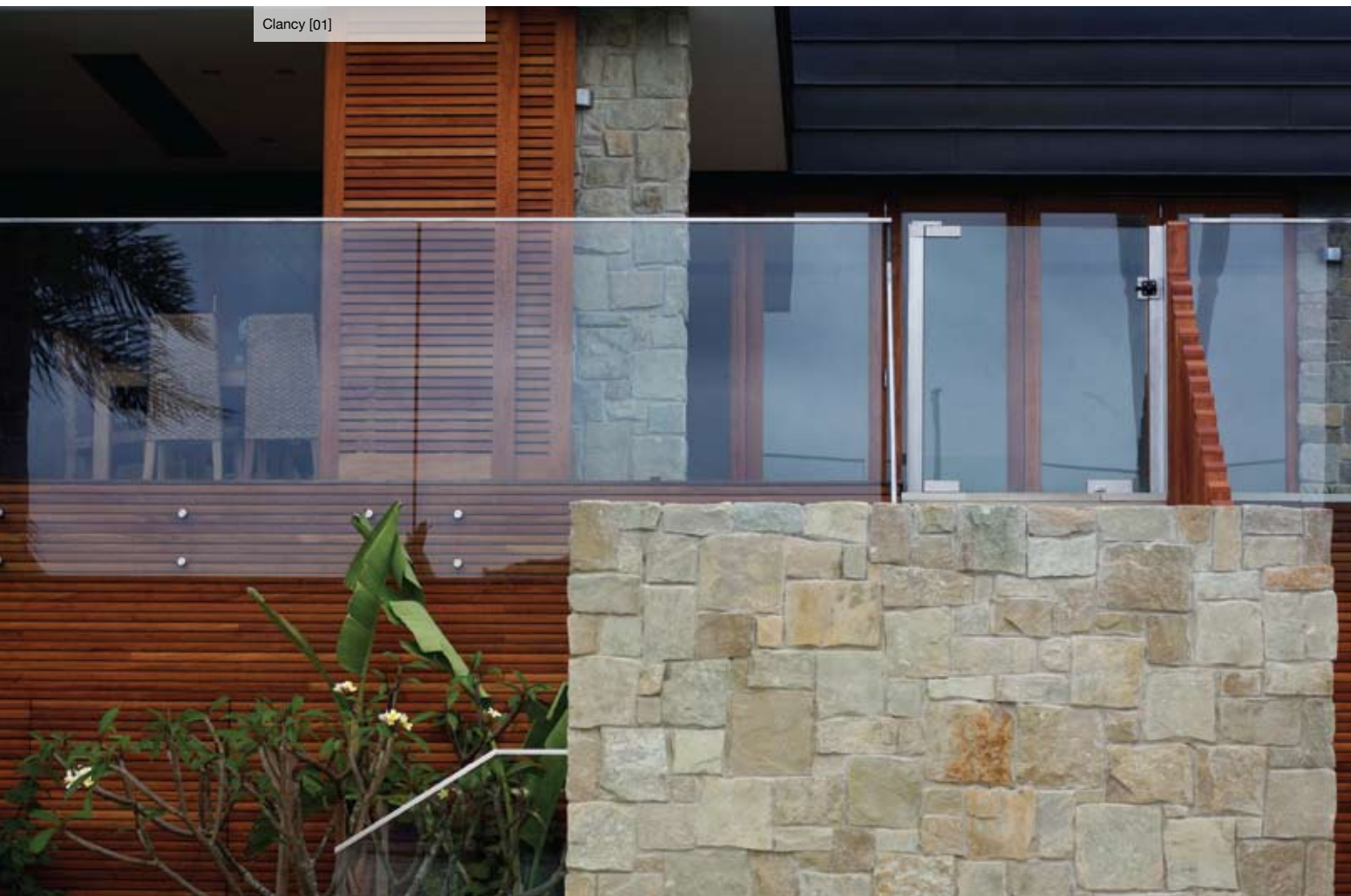

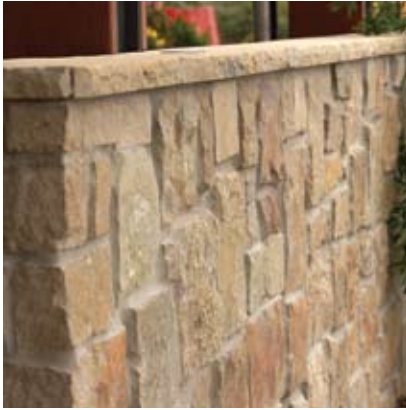

+ When it comes to cladding, capping and corner finishing details are the key to ensuring an authentic result.

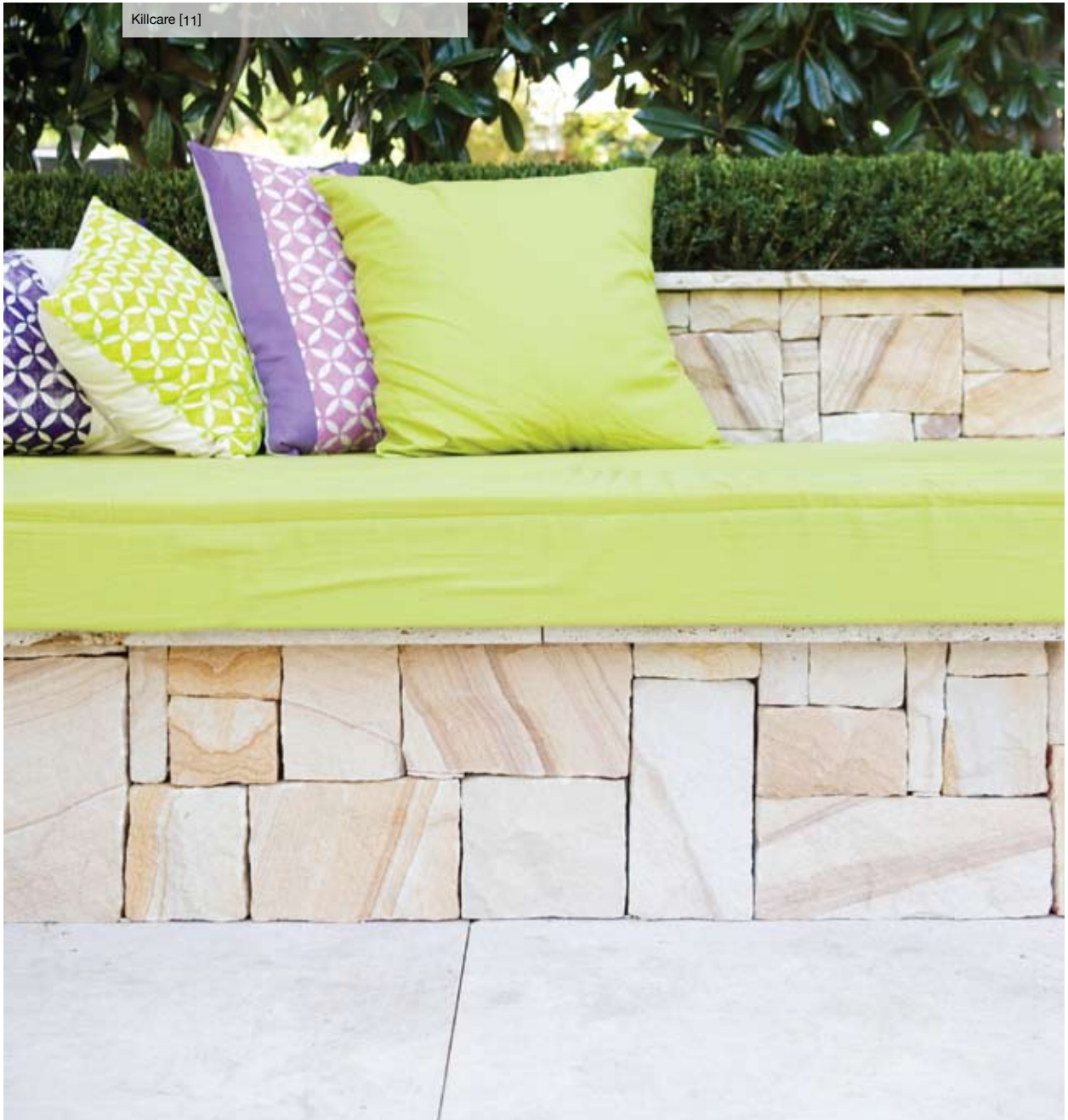

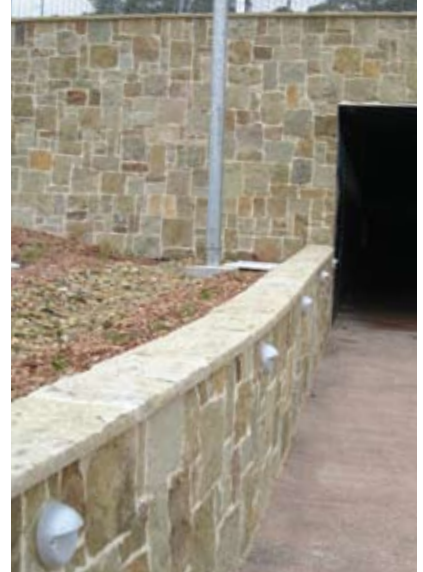

All stone pieces are split on the surface and sawn on the back, allowing easy application to suitable substrates with outstanding authentic results. Finishing details are essential when dealing with cladding products and so suitable corner and capping solutions form a key part of the range.

Sizes

Walling

Split face veneer split on 5 sides and sawn on the back. Random square and parallelogram shaped stone pieces up to 300x300mm. Thickness 20-40mm

Corners

L shaped corner pieces
Random lengths up to 300mm
Random height up to 240mm
Thickness 20-40mm

Capping

Textured finish to top surface, split on the sides and sawn on the bottom surface
Lengths 400-600mm
Thickness 30-40mm

Typically these products are adhered to a concrete or block wall with a suitable tile adhesive. Corner details are slightly different for each stone type.

When working out quantities required for a wall, you need to know the face in m² to be covered and the number of lineal meters of corners required. For further information, installation tips and pricing please call a showroom on 1300 13 14 13.
