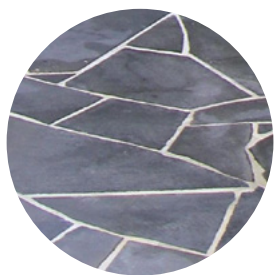
ORGANIC MOVEMENT THROUGH IRREGULAR SHAPES

Our Crazy Paving stones are dense and thus incredibly durable; have natural variation in colour and have been processed to ensure a relatively consistent dimensional accuracy.

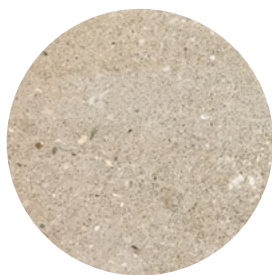




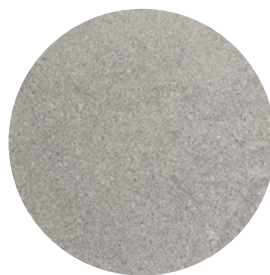

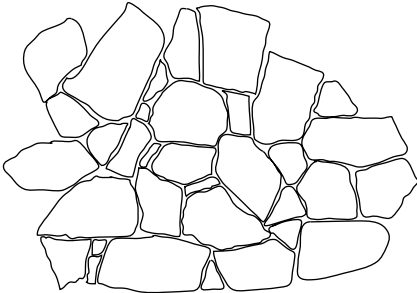
